Students, their parents, employees, and potential employees of the Hazard Independent Schools are hereby notified that the Hazard Independent Schools does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, age, religion, marital status, sex, including those with limited English proficiency or disability in employment programs, vocational programs, or activities set forth in compliance with the Office of Civil Rights, Title VI, VII, Title IX, ADA and Section 504.

The following vocational school classes are available to students in grades 11 – 12: Industrial Maintenance, Auto Body Repair, Certified Nurse’s Aide, and Medical Terminology.

Adult education classes are offered to individuals pursuing a GED certificate. Adult programs are offered periodically based upon the demand for specific classes.
